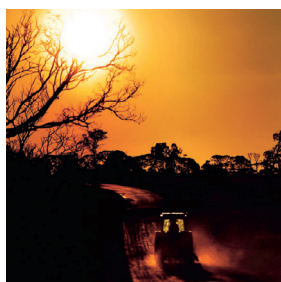

At a Glance

- Ensure all images are high resolution – minimum 200dpi.
- CMYK total ink percentage must be no more than 300% for Weekly publications.
- CMYK total ink percentage must be no more than 240% for The Age.
- PDFs made from Word, Excel, Publisher or PowerPoint are not accepted.
- Page size set to the actual size of the final advertisement. Bleed and registration marks are not required.
- All logos used should be either single bitmap or vector artwork.
- CMYK colour mode only. Pantone or RGB colour modes are not accepted.
- Convert all spot colours to CMYK.
- PDF files must be generated by converting an EPS file using Adobe Acrobat Distiller.
- All fonts must be embedded or outlined, fonts created from flattened Photoshop files as bitmaps are not acceptable.

Creating your PDF

- We ONLY accept press ready, high resolution version 1.3 PDF files.
- We recommend saving the file as an EPS out of your native program such as Indesign, Quark Express, Illustrator or Freehand and then using Acrobat Distiller to create the PDF. PDF distiller joboptions settings can be downloaded from www.adcentre.com.au or by contacting the Fairfax Production Support team on 1300 666 326.
- PDFs generated from Office packages such as Word, Excel, Publisher or PowerPoint are not accepted.

Fonts & Type

- We do not recommend reversing text out of four colour images.
- Minimum type sizes:
 - SINGLE solid colour: 6pt
 - COLOURED type on a white background using two or three colour plates: 8pt
 - COLOURED type on a white background using three colour plates: 12pt
 - REVERSED type out of one colour plates: 8pt
 - REVERSED type out of three colour plates: 12pt san serif bold

Over the phone support and training is provided.
